Hoy and Walls Community Bus Driver

OVERALL PURPOSE

Deliver a community bus service in accordance with the laid down rules for delivering a community bus service. Ensure that passengers have a friendly on time service and implement that service to a professional standard. Ensure passenger safety by ensuring all safety checks are up to date and process reports for the on-going evaluation of the community bus service.

Contribute to the effective and efficient management of the bus community bus service. Most hold as a minimum a D clarification clean driving licence.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Drive the community bus in a safe and professional manner in accordance with laid down procedure.
- Assist less able passengers on and off the bus in accordance with Midas training.
- Record, and collate, passenger usage numbers.

• Reconcile ticket usage and cash and at the end of each day, cash up and store cash securely.

• Complete daily vehicle checks and update vehicle check forms.

• Ensure good passenger relationships and as the public face of the service ensure you present a high standard of personal appearance and hygiene.

• Ensure vehicles undergo a full safety check.

• Check road conditions and judge whether it is safe to operate the bus service and inform your line manage if not.

• Contribute to actions to ensure that the Trust communicates effectively with the wider community.

• Undertake any other duties deemed suitable and agreed by the Board.
